## ACCESS TO HEALTHCARE

The Ixopo Clinic is providing a Mobile Clinic to the Woza Moya site. This operates once a month and aims to increase the access to primary health care to all community members. With out this service many people would have to make the long journey into Ixopo. More than 150 people utilise the Mobile Clinic for services such as baby immunization, distribution of chronic medications, pregnancy tests, HIV, Diabetes and High blood pressure.
