UTHINGO NETWORK WORKSHOP

Woza Moya in partnership with the *Uthingo Network*, an NGO based in Pietermaritzburg, conducted training with all staff members including Community Care Givers to raise awareness on how we can better support the LGBTQI+ community in Ufafa Valley. The Uthingo network is an Organization that works with LGBTQI+ individuals in promoting recognition of the LGBTQI+ community through institutional change and participation in rural communities together with authorities and service providers. The workshop aimed to sensitise our staff who work with the local community to LGBTQI+ rights, challenges and needs. Discussions were focused on topics which included sexual orientation, gender identity and effects of stigma and discrimination. We believe in empowering our staff with such needed information they will share it with their families and friends in order for the community to change the type of behaviour and attitude they display towards these vulnerable groups.
