OTHER NEWS FROM WOZA MOYA:

- Full Board Meeting attended by all Directors took place in Durban on 7th September.
- Health Manager & ECD Practitioner visited NGO Siyakwazi siyakwazi.org to learn more about how to support children in rural areas with disabilities.
- · Woza Moya Paralegal, Sbonelo Ndlovu attended the Dullah Omar School for Paralegalism in Cape Town for 5 days of accredited training, covering Customary Law, Labour Law, Children's Act, Land Matters and Mediation.
- All Community Care Givers & ECD practitioners in Ufafa received excellent trainings from CHOC choc.org.za More than 50% of children with Cancer in South Africa are either not diagnosed at all or else very late, leading to disabilities and death. The workshop covered cancer in children, early detection, cultural beliefs, and stigma.
- Woza Moya Youth arranged a wonderful celebration of young local talent in Ufafa, Sheshe Hall on Heritage Day. They invited NGO partners MOYA LIVE from Johannesburg livemoya.com to mobilise young males to become circumcised and implementing Health partner NEW START from Pietermaritzburg to provide direct mobile clinic services with health professionals on board. Circumcision reduces the transmission of HIV by about 60% newstart.co.za/what-we-do/mmc This led to 33 young boys being circumcised at Woza Moya the following day.
- Youth Intern, Thabiso Radebe attended a Case Management Workshop held in Durban for 2 days.
- Congratulations to Woza Moya staff member Mthobisi Mthembu on his marriage! Wishing Mr & Mrs Mthembu a long and happy life together!






